
Federation Cup Volleyball: Tamil Nadu men, Kerala women win titles

Central Chronicle News

Thrilling finals marked the climax of the 37th Federation Cup Volleyball Championship with packed stands.

RAIPUR: The 37th Federation Cup Volleyball Championship concluded on a high note at the Balbir Singh Juneja Indoor Stadium, delivering electrifying action and high-quality volleyball in both men's and women's finals. A large and enthusiastic crowd witnessed Tamil Nadu emerge men's champions, while Kerala lifted the women's title, capping a memorable final day of competition.

In the men's final, Tamil Nadu defeated Kerala 3-1 in a closely fought encounter. Tamil Nadu began aggressively, taking the first set 25-12 with clinical attacking and solid blocking. Kerala bounced back strongly in the second set, tightening their defence and winning 25-19 to level the match. However, Tamil Nadu regained control in the third set, winning 25-18 through superior net play. The fourth set turned into a tense battle of nerves, with both teams trading points before Tamil Nadu edged it 29-27 to seal the cham-

pionship.

The women's final saw Kerala deliver a commanding performance against Indian Railways, winning in straight sets 3-0. Kerala displayed remarkable consistency and coordination, taking the match 25-22, 25-21, 25-23. Their sharp serves
